 Maj. Santosh Umrikhshnan, M.C. (15 March 1977-28 November 2008) was an Indian officer, who was awarded as the 51 **National Action Group**, of the **National Security Guard** in **deputation**. He was involved during the **November 2008 Mumbai attacks**. He was subsequently awarded the **Arjuna Award**, **Indian High** **Peace** **gallantry** **award**, on 26 January 2009.

Refugee Late Gurtej Singh
 Gurtej Singh, during **Operation Black** **LEOPARD** in **Indian** **army** (**Colonel** **Latika**), on 15 June 2020, was performing the duties of the **commander** of the **Operational** **District** and was killed in **Operation** **Black**.

K. Kalani
Kalani (**General** **K. Kalani**) was **killed** in **Operation** **Black** (**Colonel** **Latika**) as part of **SRON** **LEOPARD**. On night of 15 June 2020, he was **part** of **force** of 16 **troops** **to** **establish** an **Observation** **Post** on **A** **new** **road** **right** **and** **height** **visibility** **and** **scope** for **subordinate** from the **aggressive** **action** of the **group** **soldiers**.


Bikkumalla Santosh Baba
 Colonel **Bikkumalla Santosh Baba** (MVC) (3 February 1983-15 June 2020) was an Indian Army officer and the commanding officer and of 16 **Colon** **Regiment**. He was killed in action during the **2019** **China** **border** **conflict**.

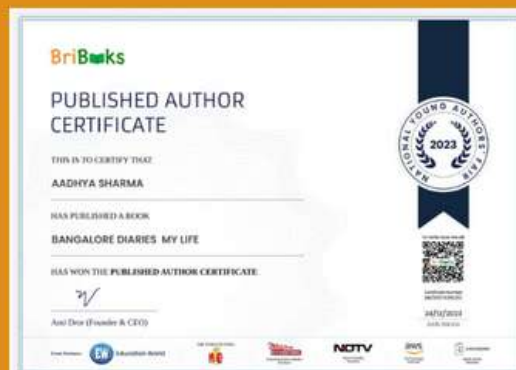
SCIENCE EXHIBITION

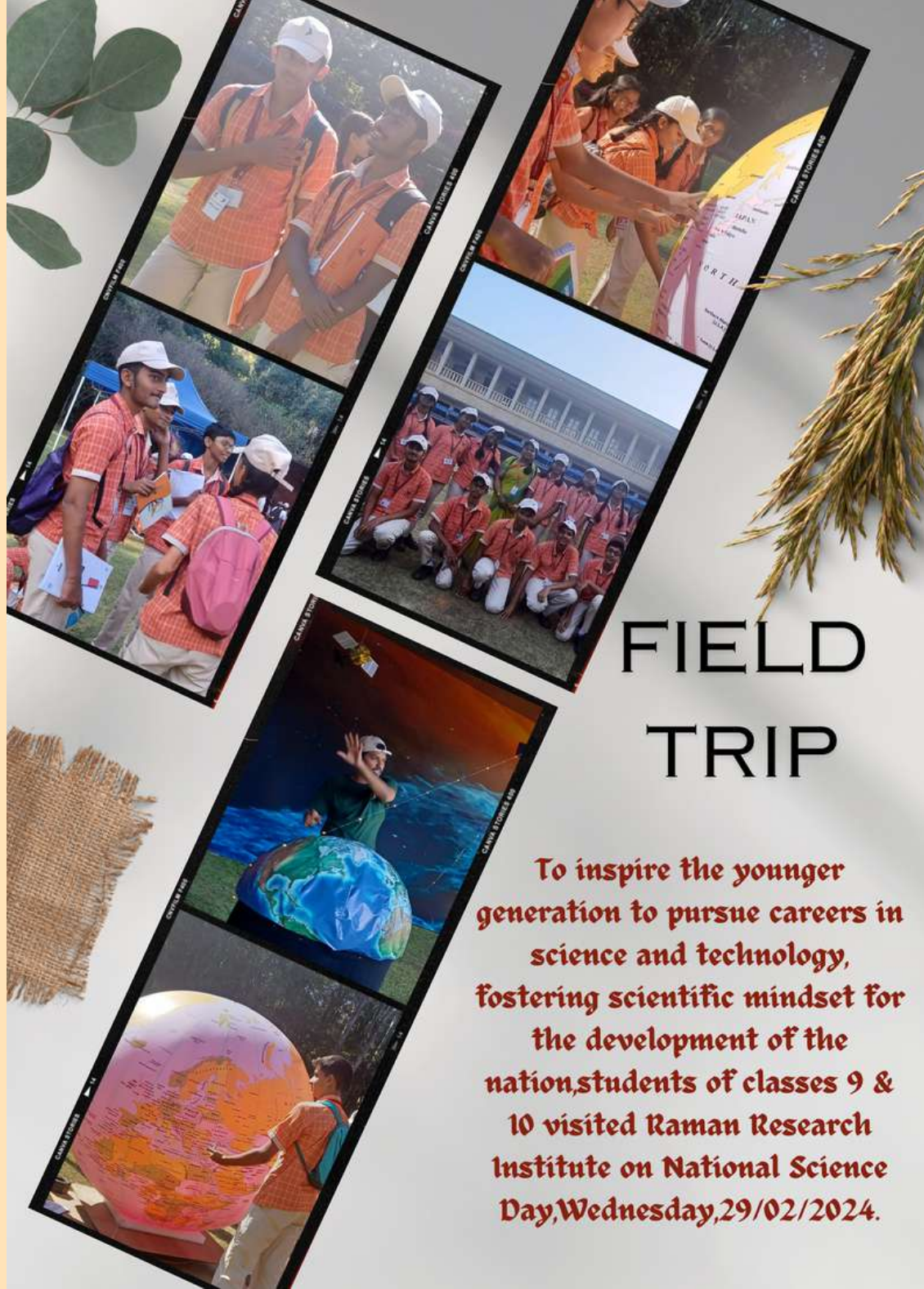

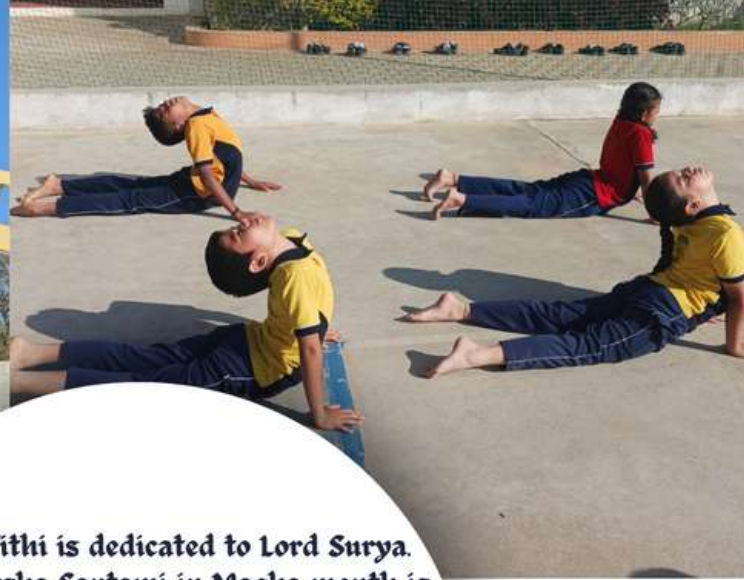

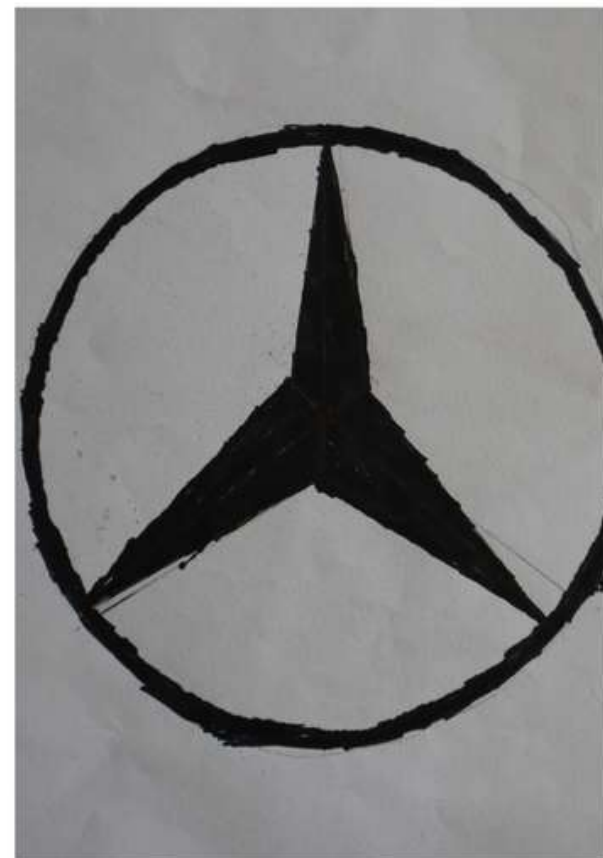
