*Our young talents explore air-mindness by constructing models by one's own hands, while they understand the various principle of flight and problems of construction.*

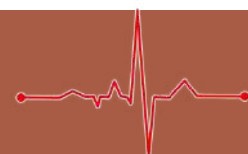
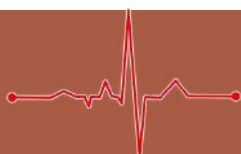

*All our students are exposed to the teachings of Bhagvad Gita which helps them fight issues like anxiety and self-doubt in student life.*



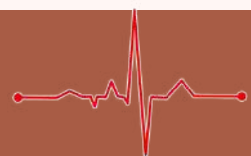
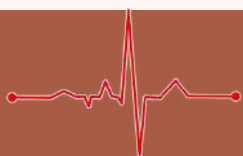
