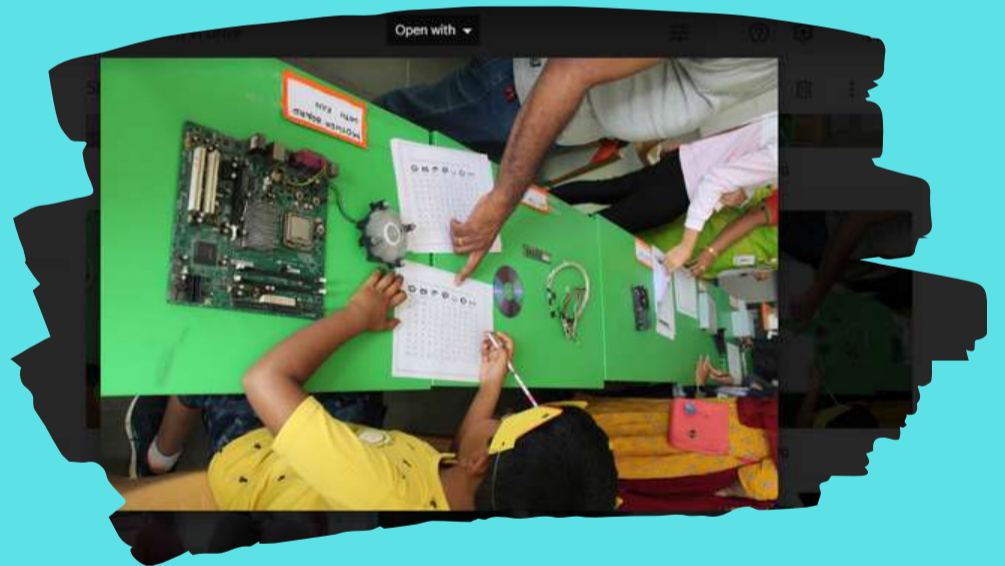

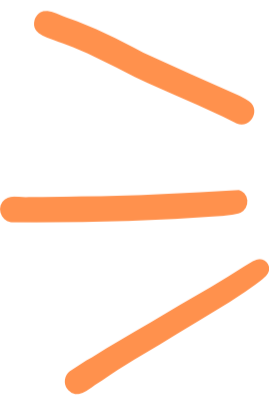
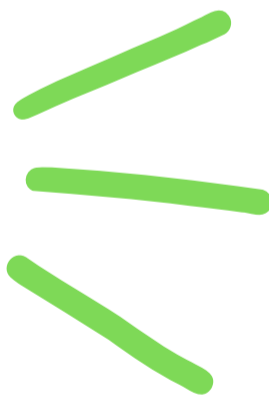
# Republic Day
